RULES:

1. Youth Show open to all bonafide 4-H and FFA members between the ages of 5-18 who are currently enrolled in school or are home schooled, and own poultry in Jackson, Washington, Calhoun, Holmes, Liberty, and Bay counties. Also, individuals in adjoining counties in Alabama (Houston Co.) and Georgia (Seminole Co.) will be allowed to exhibit birds. Entry forms must be signed by 4-H club leader or Extension Agent, or by FFA advisor.
2. 4-H Cloverbuds between the ages of 5-7 may exhibit their poultry, but will only receive participation ribbons.
3. This is a Youth Show only. There will be **no** Open Show for adults.
4. All poultry going to public exhibition must have been pullerum-typhoid tested within 90 days prior to exhibition and be free of, and must not be exposed to, infectious or contagious diseases of poultry. A Livestock Inspector will be on hand at Check-in to bleed all poultry.
5. A maximum of **10 birds per exhibitor** will be allowed. There will be a **\$3.00 entry fee, per bird, for this event.**
6. All entries are to be judged using the American Standard of Perfection. Birds shown as breeders must have sales receipt or other identification-giving name of breed. All birds will be entered as singles, unless otherwise stated. **All birds may be ID banded at registration.**
7. Entries will be received **4:00 to 6:00 PM, Monday**, and remain until **Friday, 2:00PM**, and must be removed by 4:00PM. **Fair will not be responsible for animals left after 4:00PM.**
8. General rules apply to health on arrival. Poultry will be fed and watered at 7 AM and 12 noon daily. Exhibitor must write "NO FEED OR WATER" on entry form if NOT WANTED.
9. **All poultry MUST be owned by, or in the control of, the exhibitor at least 30 days before the Show.**
10. No fighting poultry will be permitted in the Show.
11. Premiums will be given on the Danish System as follows:

CLASS:	I. Hens	IV. Cockerels	VII. Other
	II. Pullets	V. Waterfowl	
	III. Cocks	VI. Turkey/Peacock	
12. Exhibitors of turkeys, peacocks, and other large birds will furnish their own cages. Also, quail or small bird exhibitors will furnish their own cages.
13. Exhibitions only for commercial birds, such as pigeons, may be allowed as, or if, space permits. No trophies, ribbons, or premiums will be awarded. This will be the discretion of show chairman or co-chairman.
14. Entry forms are due **September 15th**. Entries received after the 15th will be charged a \$10.00 late fee. No entries will be accepted after September 29th.
15. Spectators and Exhibitors are asked to wait outside the Barn during the animal judging. The Judge will answer any questions after judging is completed.
16. All grievances must be brought before the Grievance Committee for consideration and resolution, as stated in the General Rules.

17. **Trophies** and a **\$10 premium** will be awarded to winners of "Best of Show" from PRODUCTION BIRD, MEAT BIRD, and EXOTIC BIRD divisions, in the Youth Show (excluding 5-7 year youth).

18. **Premium checks will be distributed when exhibitors pick up their birds, on Friday, from 4:00 to 6:00PM, during Check-out.**

Exhibitors may pick up ribbons and trophies between 4:00 and 6:00 PM the day of the Show.
