1. This contest is open to bonafide 4-H and FFA members from Jackson, Washington, Calhoun, Holmes, and Liberty counties.
  - a. 4-H Juniors (8-10 years old as of September 1<sup>st</sup>)
  - b. 4-H Intermediates (11-13 years old as of September)
  - c. FFA Intermediates (6<sup>th</sup> -8<sup>th</sup> grades)
  - d. 4-H Seniors (14-18 years old as of September 1<sup>st</sup>)
  - e. FFA Seniors (9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grades)
2. Teams will consist of at least 3, but no more than 4 members.
3. 4-H and FFA will judge the same classes, but will not compete against each other.
4. There is no limit to the number of teams that 4-H or FFA can enter.
5. Teams and individuals will judge a total of 8 classes:
  - a. 3 beef classes
  - b. 2 swine classes
  - c. 3 classes of crops (could be oats, corn, hay, or soybeans)
6. Youth will have eight (8) minutes to judge each class and one (1) minute to rotate to the next class.
7. Registration will begin at 8:30 in the Ag Center Auditorium lobby. No youth are allowed in the lobby- only 4-H leaders and FFA advisors please.
8. It is the responsibility of 4-H leaders and FFA advisors to make sure that their teams are properly registered.
9. Youth need to provide their own clipboards and pencils.
10. Clubs and chapters need to provide their mailing address.

1 <sup>st</sup> place team	Trophy, and blue strip ribbons for each team member
2 <sup>nd</sup> place team	Trophy, and red strip ribbons for each team member
3 <sup>rd</sup> place team	Trophy, and white strip ribbons for each team member
1 <sup>st</sup> place individual	Trophy, and blue strip ribbon
2 <sup>nd</sup> place individual	Trophy, and red strip ribbon
3 <sup>rd</sup> place individual	Trophy, white strip ribbon
